# WRBS AUCTION RULES

- 1 Prior to the start of the auction each intending bidder is required to complete a registration form & receive a bidder's number
- 2 The registration form will ask for your address contact number & payment details
- 3 The bidder's number will be required to purchase any lot / lots at auction and must be shown to the auctioneer at the fall of the hammer
- 4 Judging Sticks and Carry Cages will not be allowed into Auction Room. The Birds must not be interfered with or subjected to sticks, pens, or similar objects. **SMOKING** will **NOT** be permitted in the auction room at any time
- 5 All lots will be submitted in catalogue order; however if necessary the organizers reserve the right to make any alterations, additions or deletions to the catalogue order.
- 6 All Conditions and warranties expressed or implied by law are hereby excluded and as all lots are open for inspection prior to the commencement of the sale, the same are sold with all faults, if any. Therefore, no compensation shall be made in respect of any faults or imperfection or error of description of any lots sold or otherwise. At the fall of the hammer each lot shall be at the purchaser's risk
- 7 After the fall of the hammer no party will be allowed to retract his / her bid
- At the fall of the hammer the highest bidder shall be the purchaser, and in the event of any disputes arising the lot in dispute shall be put up again and the auctioneer's decision will be final
- 8 The auctioneer reserves the right to accept or refuse any bid without having to state the reason or reasons thereof.
- 9 Telephone bidding will be available provided **prior arrangements** have been made. Payment arrangements must be confirmed before the auction
- 10 Payment for goods on the day shall be by **CASH**, **MASTERCARD**, **VISA** unless prior arrangements have been made. There will be no surcharge on Credit Card purchases. Personal cheques will not be accepted on the day of the sale without prior arrangements.
- 11 Successful purchasers of lots will be required to take their purchases with them at the completion of the auction
- 12 If any successful bidder shall fail to pay for their purchases on the day the vendor or his/hers agents have the right to resell the lot in any manner they think proper.
- 13 It is preferred that birds are collected at the completion of the auction
- 14 Purchases may be collected 20 mins after the completion of the auction. A receipt of purchase must be obtained from the cashier upon payment of the lot, then proceed to the allocated collection point with their carry cage and evidence of purchase. The purchaser will be required to remove the bird or birds from the sale cage and transfer it or them to their own cage. The vendor, or his /her agents, the auctioneer or any staff will not be handling the birds. It is the sole responsibility of each purchaser to handle his/her own birds at collection.

Please note that carry cages will not be available at the auction & it is the responsibility of the purchaser to their own cages

### **Matt Holyoak NSW**

I have been breeding Budgies for 12 years and have been the President of the Pied Budgerigar Society for the past 6 years. I am also the current Show Manager of Budgie NSW.

I am an Open Breeder, but do not show often due to work commitments on weekends. My only show being the State Team Challenge, making my birds available for the Pied Society team.

My birds are made up of the following bloodlines: Thurn, Denning and Chris Rogers.

I have had numerous results in the top 10 at state level and am fortunate enough to have 12 birds represent NSW at the Nationals. 2011 = 6<sup>th</sup> Clearwing, 2013= 3<sup>rd</sup> Lutino, 2014 = 4<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> Clearwings, 2015 = 9<sup>th</sup> Grey, 2016 = 4<sup>th</sup> Grey, 2017 = 13<sup>th</sup> Crest, 2018 = 2<sup>nd</sup> Albino & 3<sup>rd</sup> Clearwing. 2019 = 2nd Spangle AOSV, 2022 = 2nd Lutino, 6<sup>th</sup> Yellowface. Also in 2020 I had 2 x birds placed 1st at NSW State show in Cinnamon And Fallow and a 3rd in Albino. Subsequently there was no Nationals for these 3 birds to compete in.

### W & G Robinson Sth Qld Open breeder & National Judge

Wayne began breeding & showing budgerigars as a Junior After a long absence returned to the hobby & with the help of his Mum Gwen they have represented SQBBA at National level since 2003 with Normals Spangles Recessive Pieds Opalines & Lutinos

### Jamie Wright Sth Qld

Jamie is an Open breeder & judge . He has produced some beautiful birds & has done very well on the local show bench. The stud has represented SQBBA at the Nationals in the Lacewing, Spangle, Opaline AOSV & Normal Blue classes. Winning the Lacewing in 2012 & Normal Greygreen 2017 was a highlight. Bloodlines in the stud include Sheppard & Flanagan

### **Garry & Helen Hibberd Sth Qld**

Garry & Helen are open exhibitors who started breeding budgerigars 30 years ago in the Warwick club then joined Ipswich and now are members of Toowoomba club. They achieved intermediate level before scaling back due to work until 2014 In 2015 they had 2 birds selected in the SQ team a Spangle AOSV that ran 7th and an Opaline AOSV that ran 14<sup>th</sup>. 2019 in Brisbane with Lutino they achieved 1<sup>st</sup> place and at 2022 Nationals 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Spangle AOSV 3<sup>rd</sup> Lutino 5<sup>th</sup> Opaline AOSV They concentrate on Spangles and Lutinos

Well known open breeder & National Judge Alan has had many wins at the Nationals over the years & was inducted into the Hall of Fame in 1994 In 2018 Alan came first & second in Recessive Pied Class In 2019 2<sup>nd</sup> in Recessive Pied & 2 Whitecaps in the demo class

Peter Thurn; VIC ANBC Hall of Fame Member of Melton & District Budgerigar Society Peter is a National Judge, who has been very successful on Victorian Show bench achieving Champion Exhibitor Status in 2009 Commenced breeding budgerigars in 2003 & breeds the following varieties Normals, Cinnamons, Opalines, Dominant Pieds, Spangles, Clearbodies, Fallows, Albinos, English & Aust Yellowfaces He has had many birds represent Vic at the Nationals with 7 wins Albino 08 Dominant Pied, Fallow. Clearbody 2009, 2011, 2012, 2014 with a Dilute & numerous other placings 2019 1st with Fallow

**Brian Walters Sth Old:** Brian is an open breeder who has been very successful on the local show scene. He represented Sth Qld Zone at 2018 Nationals with Normal Opaline & Opaline AOSV. 2019 Nationals with Normal Opaline & Lacewing

### Kev O'Callaghan Nth Qld

Kev & Family have represented N&C Qld Zone in the ANBC Nationals many times with different varieties and have gained numerous placing's over the years including 1<sup>st</sup> in Cinnamon in 2012, 1<sup>st</sup> in Violet in 2013, 2<sup>nd</sup> in Yellowface in 2016 In 2017 6<sup>th</sup> in Violet & 9<sup>th</sup> Lacewing 2019 Nationals Whitecap demo class 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placings In 2022 1<sup>st</sup> Aust Whitecap

### John Ennis Vic

I live in Geelong Victoria & started breeding in 2006

My flock is over 300 birds & I breed 200/300 a year. My birds are probably best known for their size & power. I place big emphasis on health & fertility

Varieties kept Spangles, Opalines, Normal, English Yellowface, Texas Clearbodies, Albinos & Greywings John has had 3 National wins Yellowface 2012 Spangle Normal 2015 Opaline AOSV 2017 other placings Clearbodies 2 3rds & a 5<sup>th</sup> Second with a Greywing 2014 4<sup>th</sup> with Opaline 2015 4<sup>th</sup> with a Violet 2017 in 2018 3<sup>rd</sup> Normal Blue & Yellowface 2019 5<sup>th</sup> Albino & 3<sup>rd</sup> Clearbody

John has also had 11 Victorian State Shield wins

Michael Pace Nth Old Michael is a North Queensland breeder with over 40 birds making the national bench in recent years with 2 ANBC wins in the Normal blue and Opaline classes. He keeps between 250 - 300 birds and breeds around 200 annually. Most of the main varieties are kept along with some Lutinos for good measure. Bloodlines are mainly Gary Gazzard, and Mark Fellows along with the occasional outcross from other prominent studs. The real highlight for breeding exhibition budgerigars for Michael is the people he has met and made lifelong friends with and breeding the occasional fluffy one.

### **Garry Edwards Sth Old**

Open Breeder Garry has been breeding budgerigars since 1980 with good success on the show bench He has also represented Sth Qld on the National level with Normal Greygreen, Dominant Pied, Cinnamon Spangle Double Factor & Dilute In 2022 Nationals his Dominant Pied got a 1<sup>st</sup> & Normal Green gained 2<sup>nd</sup> place His stud consists of bloodlines from Ken Dunk Bob Smith Alan Kent & Gary Gazzard

### John Boss NSW

John was a well-known very successful breeder in Sth Qld before defecting to NSW where he has continued with much success on the NSW show bench. His stud is based on bloodlines from top NSW breeders. John has represented NSW at National level gaining 6<sup>th</sup> place in Lutino in 2015 & winning both Normal Green & Opaline Normal in 2017 2019 Nationals 7<sup>th</sup> Spangle Double Factor

<u>Troy Holmes; SA</u> After re-joining the hobby in 2005, Troy Holmes has consistently had birds represented at the Nationals level for South Australia, with his first national win coming in 2018 in the Grey Green class. Troy keeps only a very limited number of birds, with a strong focus on modern face. The stud is built primarily around Gazzard and Capper bloodlines. 2019 Nationals Troy had 7 birds in the SA team

### **David Kelleher NSW**

I have bred Normals Cinnamons Pieds & Spangles. My bloodlines is Welshman recently adding Kent & Fellows. I have had 5 birds represent NSW at the Nationals Have won 4 Grand Champions & numerous Best of Variety awards.

### Mal Lawn Sth Old (Open Breeder)

Mal bred budgies successfully for about 7 years with many show awards. He then had a break & came back into the hobby about 5 years ago. Mal has won 5 SQ Future Show Awards & has had birds in the SQBBA National Team. Mal's Stud is based on bloodlines from Ken Dunk, Alan Kent, Brian Walters, Gary Gazzard & Cedric Webber

### Wayne Cachia Vic

Wayne has been a Western Suburbs (Vic) club member since 2011, successfully becoming a Champion breeder in 2017. He breeds Normals as well as Fallows, Lutino's, Albino's and Clearbodies. Achievements include winner of 9 classes at Victorian State shows (4 UBC, 4 Young and 1 Adult), Eastern Diploma in 2016, UBC Diploma Geelong 2016 and 7 Reps in Victorian team at ANBC Nationals. Started breeding Budgerigars in 2015 as a Victorian beginner in South West Victoria under the code MH10, taking only 4.5 years to move into Champion Breeder status in Victoria, 2020. With select showing, Mike has 3 x Diploma's, 2 x Best UBC in Shows, 7 x State Shield wins. The biggest highlight to date, was winning 'Best in Show' at the 2020 Victorian Adult Shield, with our first National Selection, and going on to winning 2<sup>nd</sup> Spangle at the Brisbane Nationals.

### **Boal Family Sth Qld**

South Qld Open breeders The Family comprises Bill Boal who has been breeding for over 35 years, Mitchell Boal who has been breeding for 25 years and Anthony Boal who has been breeding for over 20 years. All have been Wynnum Redlands members with Mitchell and Anthony being Wynnum juniors.

We had a 10-year break from the hobby after being very successful at state pre selections and National level having many high placements and winning the Spangle class in Canberra. The Family have been back breeding & showing now for  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.

The lines we have implemented are a high level of Mark Hawke and Peter Thurn, Rob Dunstan, Rowe Brothers, Tony Appleton with the crests all based on Sheppard and Flanagan lines In 2022 numerous birds in SQ team including 3 Yellowfaces running 1<sup>st</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> 7<sup>th</sup>
