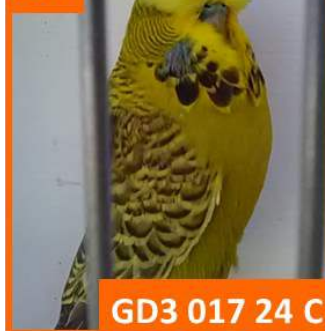

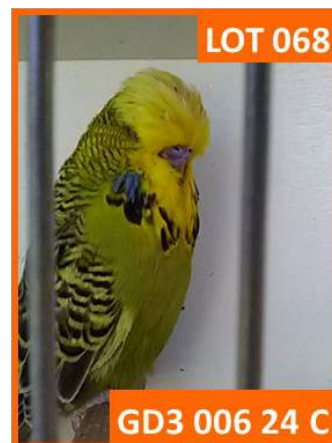

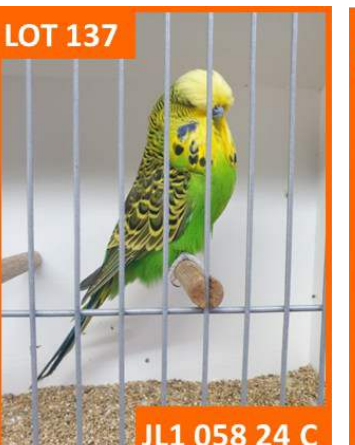

Any Person that Attends our Annual Auction is at the Invitation of The Geelong & District Budgerigar Society Inc. Any Person/s can be removed from the Auction at any time, at the Discretion of the Geelong & District Budgerigar Society Inc.

RULES, TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The sale is an unreserved Auction of Birds listed in the Catalogue.
2. Each intending purchaser attending the Auction will be required to fill out their Details in the Registration Book provided as they enter the Hall. Once Registered they will then be given a Numbered Bidders Paddle.
3. Transport Cages will not be allowed into the main body of the Auction Hall until the Conclusion of the Auction. Or if they are Clearly Marked with the Owners Name, may be placed in a prearranged part of the Hall for Collection AFTER the Conclusion of Auction.
4. The Geelong & District Budgerigar Society Inc. acts as Agents Only in respect of the Sale of Birds & IS NOT Responsible for any Faults or Defects in any lot. The VENDORS & the AUCTIONEER are also not Responsible for Faults or Defects in any lot.
5. All Statements in the Catalogue or attached to show cages as to Origin, Genuineness, Provenance or Condition of any lot should not be relied upon as Statements or Representatives of Fact.
6. INTENDING PURCHASERS MUST SATISFY THEMSELVES as to the SEX, COLOUR, VARIETY, ORIGIN, AGE, GUENUINENESS & CONDITION of ANY LOT.
7. The Birds MUST NOT be Interfered with or Subjected to Judging Sticks, Pens or Similar Objects.
8. Unless otherwise specifically stated by the Auctioneer, each bid shall be at least \$5 in advance of the previous one. The Auctioneer reserves the right to accept any bid/s, without question.
9. To prevent any inaccuracy in delivery, no Lot can be removed during the time of Sale.
10. Each lot will be sold to the Highest Bidder. Persons unfamiliar with Auction practice should ensure that the Auctioneer correctly acknowledges their bids. It is suggested that bids are called out or that a certain bid called for, that the intending purchaser raise their Bidders Number high in the air to attract the Auctioneers attention. Nods, Winks, Finger Gestures etc won't be accepted & can all be easily missed!
