# AUCTION INFORMATION

## PRE AUCTION:

- It is the responsibility of Vendors to arrange and/or transport birds to the venue.
- Vendors are responsible to ensure the birds are presented in the best possible condition with access to millet sprays and a drinker in a standard show cage. Depending on conditions auction staff may wish to give birds water. If the Vendor is not present on or for part of the day they must give formal notice of their representative to the Auction coordinator (John Hewitt).
- Benching of birds will commence at 8.00 a.m.
- The Hall will not be open to Bidders until 9.00 a.m.
- Attendees intending to buy birds will be required to register prior to entering the Hall via the front door. Upon registration the person will be issued with a 'Bidder's Card' with their designated 'Bidder Number'. This is required and entitles a person to bid on and purchase lots presented at auction.
- No empty show or carry cages are to be brought into the auction hall.
- Despite all care exercised by both the vendors and St George Budgerigar Club no responsibility is taken for the accuracy of the information contained in this document and it is suggested purchasers inspect the Lots and form their own assessment of the bird offered .

## VIEWING:

- On the Hall opening to buyers at 9.00 a.m. the birds will be able to be viewed.
- The St George Club is not responsible for the condition or faults displayed by birds so all buyers should make use of the time allowed to assess the birds which are of interest to them.
- At no stage are the birds to be interfered with by use of judging stick, pen or any other intrusive object into the cages.
- At no stage are buyers permitted to handle the cages. Only auction staff are permitted to do so up to and included to the point of check out.
- At the commencement of the Auction buyers will be requested to take their seats to allow free access to the auction staff to move birds to and from the auction podium.

## AUCTION:

- The Auction will commence as near as possible to 10.00 a.m.
- Only registered bidders may bid for Lots presented.
- Each Lot will be presented in order of catalogue. Any bird as per catalogue not present at the auction will be deemed to be scratched. Substitutions will be notified by the auctioneer prior to the commencement and at the point of Lot offer.
- On the fall of the hammer the successful Bidder must display their Bidder Card with number to the Auctioneer. At this point onwards the responsibility for the bird rests with the purchaser.
- The highest bidder on a Lot will be deemed the purchaser. Any dispute in relation to this will be dealt with by the auctioneer who may decide the outcome on merit or if justified put the Lot back up to auction. The Auctioneer's decision is final.
- The Auctioneer reserves the right to accept or refuse any bid.
- After the fall of the hammer no winning bidder may retract their bid as the Lot is deemed to be sold.
- Any birds failing to achieve a bid will be passed in and re-auctioned at the conclusion of all original Lots.
- Any birds not paid for at the conclusion of the auction may be re-auctioned or sold by any means at the discretion of the vendor.
- Any bidder representing another party on winning a purchase is responsible for payment as the registered bidder.
- It is the responsibility of the buyer to keep a record of their purchases as no sale chits will be issued only a final invoice.

## POST AUCTION/COLLECTION:

- Payment on the day will be either by cash, Mastercard or Visa. **There is a 1.15% SURCHARGE ON CARD PURCHASES**
- The collection point will be one of the front rooms of the School of Arts accessed through the front door of the facility.
- At the conclusion or during the lunch break birds may be claimed by the purchaser after payment to the Treasurer and then taking the receipt to the collection point. Auction staff will then bring the bird to the collection point for verification, where the purchaser will then be responsible for its transfer to an appropriate carry cage. At NO stage will a Purchaser remove a bird from the display bench.
